The Plan Review staff reviews plans for construction and alteration of Class I structures for compliance with applicable adopted codes and standards, and prepares design releases for approval by the State Fire Marshal. Three main programs are included in this process: project filing, review and release documentation.

The stated goal of this process is to accurately review and release construction plans within ten working days of their filing. Another program, not directly affecting the release turnaround time, is customer correspondence.

Electronic Filing Information

NOTE: 675 IAC 12-4-7 (a) states in part: "Construction projects shall be done in compliance with the applicable rules of the commission in effect on the date the plans were **FILED** with the division". Therefore, all plans **RECEIVED** in the Plan Office on or after June 16th will be reviewed in accordance with the provisions of the 2008 codes.

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Frequently Asked Questions

Question: What documents and information are needed to obtain an early foundation release on a construction project when I don't have all the plans completed for submission?

Application for Construction Design Release (reference 675 IAC 12-6-5) and 675 IAC 12-6-14.

Answer:

Correct fees for Project (reference 675 IAC 12-6-8).

Question: I want my project to be released as soon as possible. What deficiencies commonly hold up the review process?

Answer:

- Incorrect fees (reference 675 IAC 12-3-2)
- No owner's signature. The owner's signature must be included. (reference 675 IAC 12-6-6). The signature may be original or copy.
- Incorrect or incomplete design professional certificate for projects which must be certified. The design professional must sign the application for construction design release and identify the inspecting design professional. (reference 675 IAC 12-6-6 (c)(10).

Question: If my project must be certified by a design professional, must the individual who does the construction inspection be an architect or engineer registered in Indiana?

Answer:

The inspecting design professional identified on the Application for Design Release may do the inspection for the purpose of assuring compliance with specifications, plans and designs. The design professional may, however, employ others to inspect the construction and make reports with which the design professional evaluates the construction (reference IC 25-31-1-2(d) and IC 25-4-1-18).

Question: How long does the Plan Review process take?

Answer: Plans are usually handled on the first come-first serve basis.

Normally the turnaround time in Plan Review is about ten working days.

However, it can lengthen if your plans are incomplete or in conflict with design rules.

Question: What code requirements will apply to my project?

Answer: A document called the General Administrative Rules (GAR) is the key to determining how the statewide system of codes applies to your project.

The GAR contains all of the administrative rules which affect how the codes apply to your construction project and how the codes apply to your existing building. The GAR also contains rules which govern the plan review process, so it is a vital instrument to people who use the plan review process regularly.



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Question: What buildings must have a design release issued by the office of the State Building Commissioner before construction may be done?

Answer:

- Class 1 structures. A class 1 structure is a building or structure that is intended to be or is occupied or otherwise used in any part by the public, three or more tenants, or one or more persons who act as the employees of another. The definition of a class 1 structure includes site improvements which affect accessibility to buildings which are class 1 structures.
- Buildings used only for an agricultural purpose on the land where they are located and not used for retail trade are not Class 1 structures.
- Vehicular bridges are not Class 1 structures.

Question: We are planning to build a 900-square-foot pump house within our existing municipal sewage plant facility. Will a design release be required prior to construction?

Answer:

- If the pump house is owned and used by a utility and will never be occupied or used by the public and will not normally be occupied or used by a person acting as an employee of another, the building is exempt from the design release requirement (reference 675 IAC 12-6-4).
- Several other Class 1 structures are also exempt from the design release requirement because of their use or their small size.

Question: We are going to replace our 100-ampere breaker panel with a 200-ampere panel. Must we obtain a design release for this work?

Probably not. Replacement in the same location of electrical equipment or devices with those of a similar type **Answer:** and rating including an increase in current capacity in nonhazardous areas where there is no change in voltage or phases does not require a design release (reference 675 IAC 12-6-4 (b)(3)(A)).

Question: In Indiana is polystyrene foam insulation permitted to be applied directly to the roof deck without an intervening thermal barrier?

The direct to deck application is considered an alternative method or material and is regulated by 675 IAC 12-6-11. If the application is the sole subject of an evaluation report "published by an independent, nationally recognized testing laboratory" that "contains limitations, conditions, or standards for alternative materials, method of construction, or design procedures", the State Building Commissioner and State Fire Marshal may approve the use of the application. The application for construction design release must include the evaluation report for the application being requested.



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Question: Concerning a "fire suppression submittal". Questions raised include:

- 1. What application should I be using?
- 2. How are fees calculated?
- 3. What about the standard for "400 heads and/or over"?
- 4. What needs to be included when I file now?

Answer: To answer these questions, certain things need to be taken into consideration to determine just what is necessary.

Situation 1:

I have filed for a project and was granted a release which did not include the fire suppression system(see Fire Suppression System Application (Word 97 Version). In a situation as this, you would file as always, submitting with ONLY ONE COMPLETE SET OF PLANS – which shall not be returned, so keep any other copies in your possession. Then you would calculate the fees based on the cost for a partial filing(making sure you also reference the SBC # on the former release) and make the check payable to "Dept of Fire and Building Services).

Situation 2:

I am submitting a brand new construction for which there has not been a release ever granted. You will still use the <u>Fire Suppression System Application</u>) and submit with ONLY ONE COMPLETE SET OF PLANS – which shall not be returned, so keep any other copies in your possession. There will be no need to reference a previous SBC number as one will be assigned since this will be a new project. Fees are calculated according to any other STANDARD filing but using this specific formula.

Filing:

\$69.00

The construction cost involved with the price of labor and materials required associated with the suppression system times \$.0020 (using the Category C calculation figure). This is also calculated on the basis of the floor area of each affected story.

Processing

Fee:

Add this to the above \$69.00 filing fee. Your check is to be made payable to "Dept of Fire and Building

- 1. One Application for Construction Design Release, together with correct filing fees. (See Fee Schedule)
- One complete filing (paper or e-mail). This filing will not be returned to the applicant. A set of drawings identical to those released by the Indiana Department of Homeland Security, Division of Fire and Building Safety, Plan Review Branch, shall be maintained on the project site. Weight limit of each submitted package is 30 pounds.
 - A. Site plan showing dimensioned location of building to all property lines and to all existing buildings on the property, as well as width of any streets, access roadways or easements bordering the property.
 - B. Foundation and basement plans and details.
 - C. Dimensioned floor plans for all floors.
 - D. Fire and life safety plan showing graphically or by legend the location and rating of building elements such as area separation walls, smoke barriers, fire-resistive corridor walls, stair enclosures, shaft enclosures and horizontal exists.

E. Wall elevations of all exterior walls including adjacent ground elevation.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION (Must Be Complete)

- F. Sections and details of walls, floors and roof, showing dimensions, materials.
- G. Structural plans and elevations showing size and location of all members, truss designs showing all connection details, and stress calculations.
- H. Room finish schedule showing finishes for walls, ceilings and floors in all rooms, stairways, hallways and corridors.
- I. Door schedule showing material, size, thickness and fire-resistive rating for all doors.
- J. Electrical plans, diagrams, details and grounding of service entrance and power or lighting information required for energy conservation.
- K. Plumbing plans showing location of fixtures, risers, drains, and piping isometrics.
- L. Mechanical plans showing location and size of ductwork, equipment, fire dampers, smoke dampers and equipment schedules showing capacity.
- M. Fire protection plans showing type of system, location of sprinkler heads, standpipes, hose connections, fire pumps, riser and hanger details.
